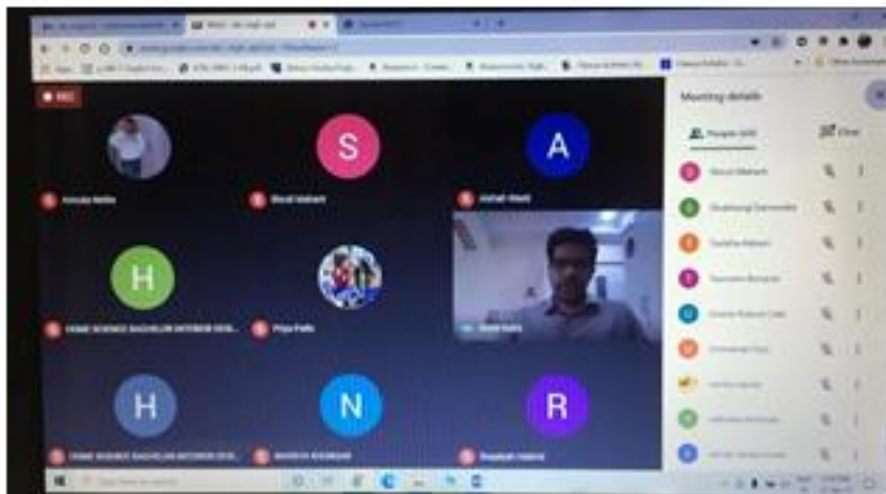
### 22 January 2021 - Talk on National Voters Day
