Recently IIT Bombay organized AICTE approved Faculty Development Programme on *Use of ICT in Education for Online and Blended Learning.* It was a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC-FDP) which was conducted from 2 May to 15 August 2016 with six day face-to face sessions at Remote Centre, VNIT, Nagpur. Three basic components of this FDP were online work by individual participants, six face-to-face interactions at the selected Remote Centre and Individual and Team assignments.

At the national level four thousand and fifty one (4051) participants were registered for this FDP, out of which two thousand one hundred and ninety three (2193) successfully completed the Programme. Out of them two hundred and fifty three (253) top performing participants were selected for SAP Excellence Award.

Dr. Shubhangi Girgaonkar and Dr. Deepali Chahande from the Department of Geography, Dr. Archana Masram from the Department of Zoology and Ms. Mrunalini Thombre from the Department of History participated in this FDP and were among the top performers. They were awarded SAP Excellence Award of ₹5,000-each. Dr. Sushma Chopde of the Department of Electronics was also declared the top performer.

The examination system has become all the more dependent on IT, and a change over to biometric system has been not without its hurdles which were however smoothly overcome by the Officers in Charge.
